



Chulalongkorn – Academic Year 2014-2015

While abroad, students continue to pay their Case tuition rather than the tuition at their new institution. In addition there are several expenses students' financial aid can potentially help to fund. These are listed in the table below.

Housing	\$3,400	Self-catered University housing. There are available private accommodations that are sponsored by the university, but the price range varies greatly.
Estimated Cost for Meals	\$3,000	Students are expected to provide their own meals

Miscellaneous Spending	\$3,600	Can include more expensive personal purchases such as clothes, haircuts, soap, shampoo, toiletries, cleaning supplies, etc.

All of these costs are considered academic in nature and can therefore be considered for coverage from financial aid. Other expenses that may receive aid include immunizations and additional passport and visa fees for students that are not US citizens.
