While abroad, students continue to pay their Case tuition rather than the tuition at their new institution. In addition there are several expenses students' financial aid can potentially help to fund. These are listed in the table below.

Housing	\$950	Residence halls are provided for international students
Estimated Cost for Meals	\$1,600	Students are expected to provide their own meals

Airfare	\$1,435	Roundtrip to Wuhan
Local Transportation	\$0	Wuhan University provides international students with bus passes
Visa	\$160	
Miscellaneous Spending	\$1,046	Can include more expensive personal purchases such as clothes, haircuts, soap, shampoo, toiletries, cleaning supplies, etc.
Total	\$5,566	

All of these costs are considered academic in nature and can therefore be considered for coverage from financial aid. Other expenses that may receive aid include immunizations and additional passport and visa fees for students that are not US citizens.

Please note that personal expenses such as travel, shopping, and going out to eat will not be covered, and should therefore be planned for accordingly.
