While abroad, students continue to pay their Case tuition rather than the tuition at their new institution. In addition there are several expenses students' financial aid can potentially help to fund. These are listed in the table below.

	Amount	Notes
Housing	\$2,200	This price is for a more expensive private accommodation, but is equivalent of a cheaper homestay.
Estimated Cost for Meals	\$2,000	Approximate cost if student is expected to provide all meals (for homestay, breakfast and dinner will be served five times per week so this number would decrease)
Books	\$150	
Passport	\$135	
Airfare	\$1,125	Roundtrip to Paris
Local Transportation	\$300	
Visa	\$140	
Miscellaneous Spending	\$1,780	Can include more expensive personal purchases such as clothes, haircuts, soap, shampoo, toiletries, cleaning supplies, etc.
Total	\$7,830	

All of these costs are considered academic in nature and can therefore be considered for coverage from financial aid. Other expenses that may receive aid include immunizations and additional passport and visa fees for students that are not US citizens.

Please note that personal expenses such as travel, shopping, and going out to eat will not be covered, and should therefore be planned for accordingly.
