While abroad, students continue to pay their Case tuition rather than the tuition at their new institution. In addition there are several expenses students' financial aid can potentially help to fund. These are listed in the table below.

Housing	\$5,700	Campus housing located about 20 minutes from campus (walking)
Estimated Cost for Meals	\$2,500	Students have access to a meal plan, but will still need to provide some of their own meals
Books	\$300	
Passport	\$135	
Airfare	\$1,280	Roundtrip to Rome
Local Transportation	\$300	
Visa	\$250	
Miscellaneous Spending	\$2,000	Can include more expensive personal purchases such as clothes, haircuts, soap, shampoo, toiletries, cleaning supplies, etc.
Total	\$12,465	

All of these costs are considered academic in nature and can therefore be considered for coverage from financial aid. Other expenses that may receive aid include immunizations and additional passport and visa fees for students that are not US citizens.

Please note that personal expenses such as travel, shopping, and going out to eat will not be covered, and should therefore be planned for accordingly.
