While abroad, students continue to pay their Case tuition rather than the tuition at their new institution. In addition there are several expenses students' financial aid can potentially help to fund. These are listed in the table below.

Estimated Cost for Meals (self-catered)	\$1,600	UCL offers accommodations with meal plans, but this will be slightly more expensive than providing your own meals.

Airfare	\$1,190	Roundtrip to Heathrow
Local Transportation	\$390	The best way to get around the urban campus is to purchase and 'top-up' an Oyster Card, which will be your ticket for buses, trains, and the underground.
Visa	N/A	US citizens are not required to obtain a Tier-4 Visa if they are not staying abroad for more than six months
Miscellaneous Spending	\$1,720	This could include clothes, haircuts, soap shampoo, toiletries, cleaning supplies, etc.

All of these costs are considered academic in nature and can therefore be considered for coverage from financial aid. Other expenses that may receive aid include immunizations and additional passport and visa fees for students that are not US citizens.
