

Cardiff University, Academic Year 2014-2015

While abroad, students continue to pay their Case tuition rather than the tuition at their new institution. In addition there are several expenses students' financial aid can potentially help to fund. These are listed in the table below.

| Miscellaneous Spending | \$3,200 | Can include more expensive personal items like soap, shampoo, toiletries, cleaning supplies, haircuts, etc. |

All of these costs are considered academic in nature and can therefore be considered for coverage from financial aid. Other expenses that may receive aid include immunizations and additional passport and visa fees for students that are not US citizens.
