While abroad, students continue to pay their Case tuition rather than the tuition at their new institution. In addition there are several expenses students' financial aid can potentially help to fund. These are listed in the table below.

	Amount	Notes
Housing	\$4,850	Does NOT include required, refundable, \$300 deposit. Cost will vary depending on which Oxford college the student is attending.
Estimated Cost for Meals (Self-catered)	\$2,500	Meal plan will vary, may be closer to \$2,000-\$2,300, but meals will not be available during Easter Holiday.
Books	\$170	
Passport	\$135	
Airfare	\$1,280	Roundtrip to Bristol
Local Transportation	N/A	Buses are available for personal travel, but students live on campus so there is no commuter fee.
Visa	N/A	US citizens are not required to obtain a Visa if they are staying abroad for less than six months.
Miscellaneous Spending	\$1,721	These can include clothes, haircuts, soap, shampoo, toiletries, cleaning supplies, etc.
Total	\$10,656	

All of these costs are academic in nature and can therefore be considered for coverage from financial aid. Other expenses that may receive aid include immunizations and additional passport and visa fees for students that are not US citizens.
