While abroad, students continue to pay their Case tuition rather than the tuition at their new institution. In addition there are several expenses students' financial aid can potentially help to fund. These are listed in the table below.

Housing	\$7,240	Does NOT include required, refundable \$300 deposit. Cost will vary depending on which Oxford college the student is attending.
Estimated Cost for Meals (Selfcatered)	\$3,300	Meal plan may cost closer to \$2,300-\$2,600, but meals will not be available over winter break or Easter Holiday
Books	\$350	•
Passport	\$135	
Airfare	\$1,280	Roundtrip to Bristol
Local Transportation	N/A	Buses are available for personal travel, but students will live on-campus so there are no commuter fees.
Visa	482	US citizens are required to obtain a Tier-4 Visa if they are staying abroad for more than six months
Miscellaneous Spending	\$3,442	These can include clothes, haircuts, soap, shampoo, toiletries, cleaning supplies, etc.

All of these costs are considered academic in nature and can therefore be considered for coverage from financial aid. Other expenses that may receive aid include immunizations and additional passport and visa fees for students that are not US citizens.
