# Hanyang University

Hanyang University is the successor of DongA Polytechnic Institute, which was established in 1939, as the first engineering college in Korea. In 1959, the Institute became more comprehensive and was upgraded to university status. Today, Hanyang is home to about 35,000 students in 23 colleges and 13 graduate schools.

To continue its momentum of progress, Hanyang University has been striving to promote internationalization and consequently, 500 courses instructed in English per semester by 150 foreign professors are now available. Also, through the Hanyang International Summer School (HISS), which offers more than 40 courses taught in English from distinguished educators, the University hosts more than 400 students from around the world. Efforts such as these have allowed Hanyang to recruit about 3,800 international students, and the University also has formal relations with over 360 universities worldwide.

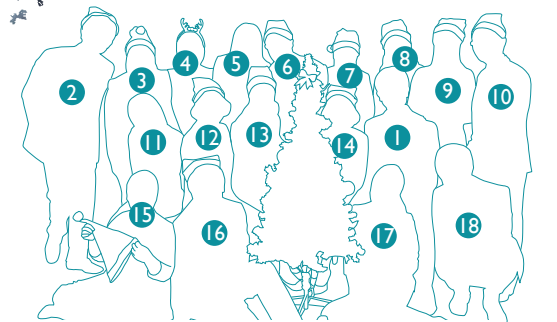

# Why Korea?

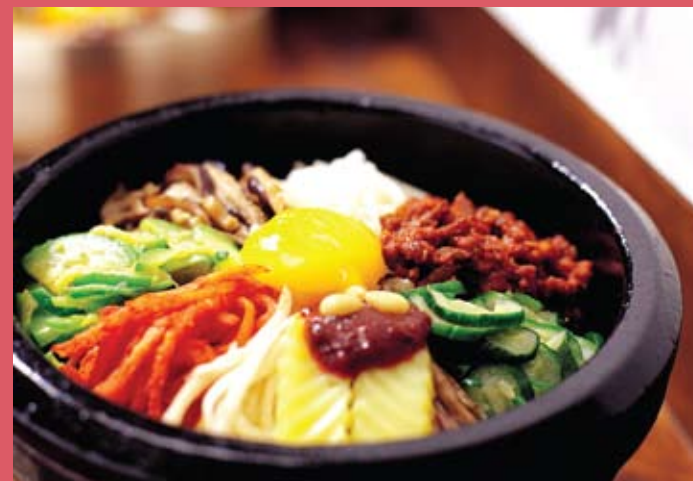
**History!** Korean history dates back as far as 2333 B.C., and thus is rich in traditions, culture, and art for appreciators to view and enjoy.

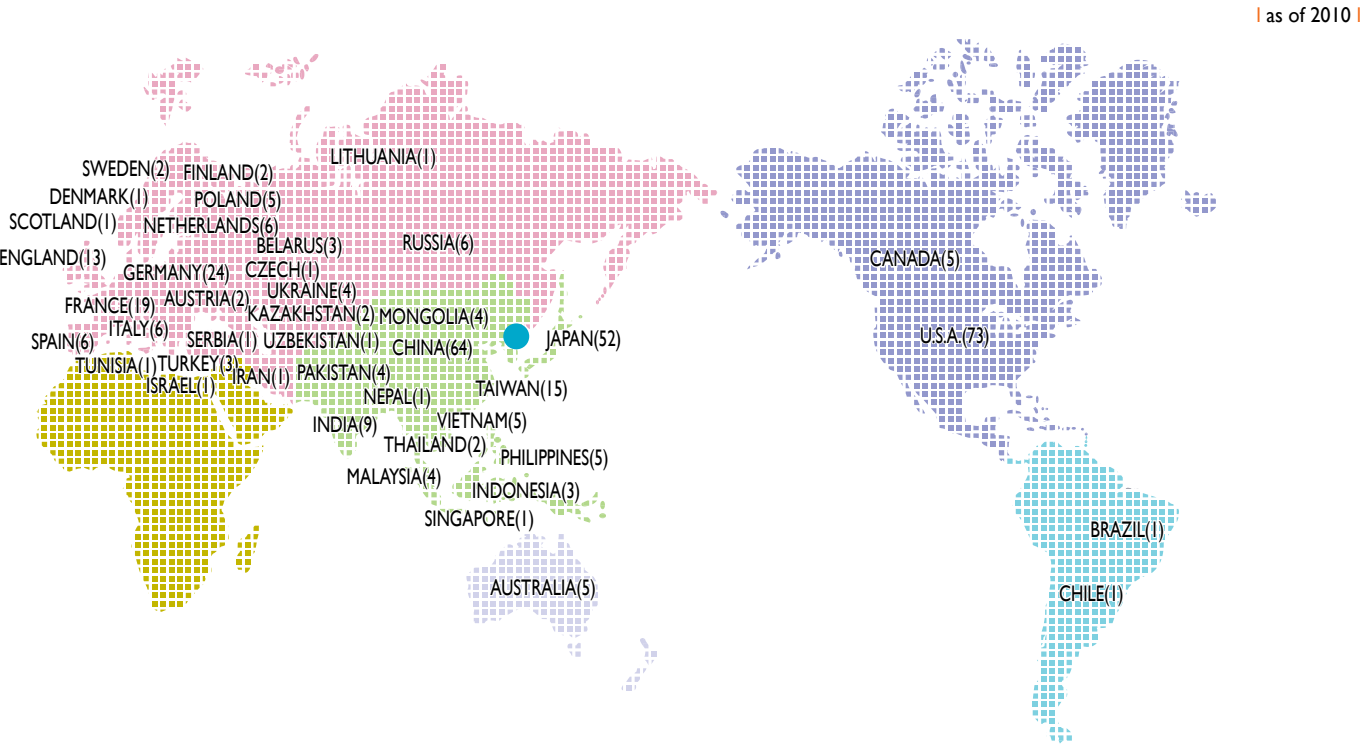

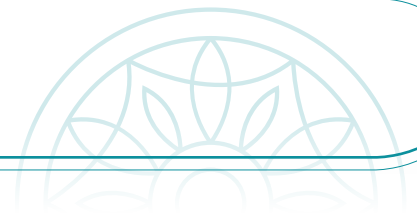

# Introduction



### Exchange Procedure

1. Official Nomination from Home University
2. Online Applications
3. Submission of Required Documents to Host University
4. Certificate of Admission

### Required Documents

1. Printed Online Application Form
2. Official Nomination Letter
3. Academic Transcripts from the Home University
4. Certificate of Enrollment
5. 2 copies of Photos (4 x 5 cm, color)
6. Passport Photocopy

### Semester Periods

Spring Semester: Beginning of March - Middle of June  
Fall Semester: Beginning of September - Middle of December

### Application Deadlines

For Spring Semester (March - June): By the end of November  
For Fall Semester (September - December): By the end of May

### Housing

All incoming reciprocal exchange students may reside in the Student Residence Hall (dormitory) on the Seoul or ERICA campuses depending on the dormitory availability. The International House and Techno Dormitory are the latest addition to the University housing and were designed exclusively for incoming exchange students. Two students share a room that is equipped with the latest amenities. The Office of International Cooperation requires a dormitory deposit of 50 US\$. When exchange students exit the dormitory room, they should apply for a dormitory deposit refund. Any damages to the dormitory facilities will be deducted from the deposit. Otherwise, the deposit will be fully refunded.



### Visa Issuance

To study in Korea, a student visa (D-2) must be obtained from the Korean Embassy or consulate abroad. In the case of short-term visits (less than 90 days) a short-term visa may be obtained, but it cannot be extended in Korea. In order to acquire a student visa (D-2), students must submit to the embassy the Certificate of Admission issued by Hanyang University. The application procedure may vary according to different embassies or consulates, so the Korean embassy or consulate in a student's home country should first be checked to determine what documents are required.

### Insurance

International students must be insured. International students are strongly encouraged to have health insurance before coming to Korea. When students visit a hospital in Korea, they must pay all fees and should keep receipts and prescriptions for reimbursement by their health insurance companies when back in their own country. If on medication, students are recommended to bring an adequate supply and/or a doctor's prescription. For students without health insurance, you can apply for Korean health insurance, during the online application. The payment will be arranged when arriving in Korea.

### Pick-up Service

Please plan to arrive in Korea at least one week before classes begin so that you can attend the Orientation for Exchange Students. The Office of International Cooperation can arrange a pick-up service upon request. For this service, each Hanyang University Coordinator will collect necessary information regarding the arrival. Please be aware that students are required to pay for the pick-up service. The fee will be 70000 KRW. (approximately US\$ 65)

### Things to do

#### Certificate of Alien Registration

International students must register as a foreigner in order to receive a foreign ID card, often referred to as an "Alien ID card". Registration must be completed within 90 days of arriving in Korea. After registering as a foreigner you will be issued a foreign ID card. There are two ways to receive the foreign ID card: the first, and most convenient way, is for the immigration office to mail you your foreign ID card and passport to a specified address; the second method is to go back to the immigration office to pick up your foreign ID card and passport in person. If you opt to have your foreign ID and passport mailed, you will be required to sign for the package upon arrival, and pay a small shipping fee.

The foreign ID card will be used in a variety of circumstances during your stay in Korea. Many places that have a specific age requirement will ask to see your foreign ID card. You will be required to present your foreign ID card when creating a mobile phone account under your name (the sooner you obtain your foreign ID, the faster you will be able to get a mobile phone account).

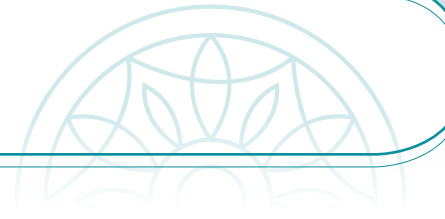

### Q1 When the semester starts?

### Q2 Can exchange students choose to stay either one or two semesters? If only one semester, can they choose which semester to study?

Yes, they can choose either spring or fall semester depending on the mutual agreement between the two universities. This should be consulted with the coordinator of home university.

### Q3 What is the application deadline and what documents are required?

Semester	Spring	Fall
Period	March 1st to June 20th	September 1st to December 20th
Deadline	Jan 1st	July 1st

### Q4 Are there any breaks during the academic year?

Schools in Korea have two seasonal vacations summer and winter. Students can choose to take summer or winter courses if they want. Besides, Korea has an average of 1 holiday each month. There are several long holidays such as Thanksgiving Holiday, Christmas Holiday, New Year Holiday, etc.

### Q5 What housing options are available for exchange students? Tell me about the cost, deadline and the required document.

- International House (Twin Bed Room) is available. Approximate dormitory cost is 920,000 KRW for 4 months or 1,380,000 KRW for 6 months.
- Spring Semester Deadline: Jan 14th and Housing Application form
- Fall Semester Deadline: July 15th and Housing Application form

### Q6 Does Hanyang offer a meal plan for students? If so, is this mandatory for students?

- There is no meal plan. However, there are many cafeterias and snack shops on campus, as well as many restaurants (Western/Korean/Japanese/Chinese food) around the campus.

### Q7 With which countries do you have exchange programs, and how many exchange students do you have per semester?

- USA, UK, Canada, Australia, France, Netherlands, Germany, Austria, Finland, Sweden, Spain, Finland, Czech Republic, Croatia, Hungary, Serbia, Russia, Lithuania, Malaysia, Poland, Turkey, Japan, China, Pakistan, Malaysia, Indonesia, Saudi Arabia, Brazil from over 300 Hanyang partners in the world
- About 200 exchange students per semester

### Q8 Does your University offer any classes taught in English? Are there any mandatory courses that students need to take from your University?

- Yes, about 35% (500) of all courses are taught in English. The course offerings in English may vary depending on the faculties and semesters.
- Depending on student's major, mandatory courses can be decided upon discussions between coordinators of home and hosting university.

### Q9 What is the regulation for the medical insurance for students?

- Exchange students must purchase the international student insurance in their home country and submit the proof to Hanyang before their arrival or on the Orientation Day.
- If no medical coverage is arranged, students are required to purchase the insurance on the Orientation in Korea, which will cost approximately 60,000 KRW for 6 months and 90,000 KRW for 12 months.

### Q10 Is there any special program that exchange students can participate in?

- No, there is not a special program offered only to exchange students, but students are usually open to take any courses of their interests across faculties.
- Exchange students can join the Hanyang International Summer School depending on the number of student exchange ([www.hanyang.ac.kr/code\\_html/HHDE/index.html](http://www.hanyang.ac.kr/code_html/HHDE/index.html))

### Q11 What is the expected budget during my stay in Korea?

Accommodation	1,380,000 KRW/6months
Food and Meals	300,000 KRW /month
Health Insurance	15,000 KRW/month
Local Transportation	40,000 KRW/month
Leisure	100,000 KRW/month
Miscellaneous	45,000 KRW/month
Total	700,000 KRW/month

- Yes, we have many historic areas nearby Hanyang University and inside Seoul. As Hanyang is located at the center of Seoul, students have a very good access to various places. Even we arrange special field trip programs for inbound Exchange students.

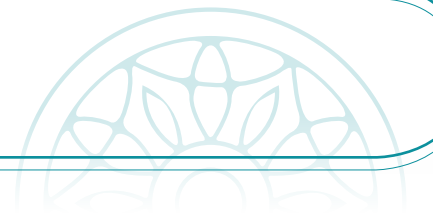
