While abroad, students continue to pay their Case tuition rather than the tuition at their new institution. In addition there are several expenses students' financial aid can potentially help to fund. These are listed in the table below.

| Local Transportation | £320 | - | Oyster card for travel zones 1-2 |

| Miscellaneous Spending | £1,100 | - | Includes bills such as gas, electricity, water, internet, phone and personal hygiene items such as soap, deodorant, shampoo etc. |
