While abroad, students continue to pay their Case tuition rather than the tuition at their new institution. In addition there are several expenses students' financial aid can potentially help to fund. These are listed in the table below.

Housing (self-catered)	£6,336	-	This is the average cost for catered accommodation.
Estimated Cost for Meals	£800	-	Try to make use of low budget grocery stores such as Lidl and Aldi to reduce the cost more. Larger stores may include Tesco, Sainsbury's or Asda.

Passport	-	\$140	If you do not already have one
Airfare	-	\$1,000	Roundtrip to Leeds. Manchester airport is another option.
Local Transportation	£400	-	Transportation is not necessary to commute to campus.
Visa	£322	-	You will need a visa if you stay more than 6 months. Please check your status at: <a href="https://www.gov.uk/check-uk-visa">https://www.gov.uk/check-uk-visa</a>
Healthcare	£150	-	Mandatory healthcare surcharge for academic year study.
Miscellaneous Spending	£2,000	-	Can include more expensive personal purchases such as clothes, haircuts, soap, shampoo, toiletries, cleaning supplies, etc.
